BACKGROUND

In 2012 authorities of the tourism sector in the Asian region highlighted the increase in Spanish speaking tourists and requested support from the Government of Colombia to train their tourist guides in Spanish as a Foreign Language.

In 2013 Colombia officialised its commitment in the Working Group of Culture, Youth, Gender and Sports of the Forum for East Asia-Latin America Cooperation, originating the initiative "ELE FOCALAE" from its Spanish acronym, which in 2017 develops its fifth version.


TOURISTIC

77% of the scholars have been tourist guides and journalists specialized in tourism, who have improved their abilities to interact with Spanish speaking tourists in their own countries.



EDUCATIONAL

23% of the scholars have been undergraduate and graduate students. This component was included in 2015, aiming to encourage the generation of long-lasting links between universities from both regions.


100% of the scholars have had the chance to experience the different Colombian cultural expressions through gastronomy, traditional rhythms and dancing, landscapes, etc. Their presence in the country has also been enriching as they have shared their traditions and cultural expressions with Colombians.



AWARD

"COLOMBIA IS WHAT I LIKE"

This competition awards two scholars a three-day, two-night trip to one of Colombia's national natural parks. The criteria for grading participants are the creativity of their publications in social media, the content, the periodicity and the use of Spanish language, among others.

Between 2013 and 2017, five editions of ELE FOCALAE have taken place and tourist guides, journalists and students from all East Asian FEALAC countries have participated.

The beneficiaries have studied Spanish as a Foreign Language in universities with the highest standards of education located in 8 Colombian cities.

ELE FOCALAE has strengthened the tourism sector of East Asia, has deepened the ties between Colombia and this Asian region, has encouraged relations between universities from both sides and has promoted Colombia as a destination to learn Spanish.
